Rehearsal Info.

In-person rehearsals are Tuesday evenings, 7:30-9:00pm, from September through April, with time off over the Christmas holidays.

A very important tip when you are singing is to hold your music high! You should be able to look over the top of it with your peripheral vision so you can watch the conductor while projecting your voice forward.

Listen closely to David's instructions and make notes as needed on your music - always in pencil. Feel free to make whatever markings will be helpful to you, whether it's the pronunciation of a particular word or specific dynamics the Music Director asks you to make.

Inclement Weather

We rely on the decision of Sheridan College as to whether we will cancel a practice or not, so if they close the college for evening classes, we will cancel the rehearsal. OC will post a notice on the main page of our website and social media if this occurs.

Dress Rehearsals and Concerts

There will always be a dress rehearsal before the concert, in the designated concert venue. At a dress rehearsal, we don't come "dressed" up; this term just means it's the final rehearsal, which includes all the singers and musicians that will be performing. So just dress casually as you would for any other rehearsal.

Our concert attire is usually uniform and basically all black. More details will be provided nearer to the performance dates.

Our financial year is July 1 to June 30. The Annual General Meeting is held before a rehearsal in the Fall.

We have some fixed and variable expenditures. The Music Director, Accompanist and Section Leads are paid positions. We also pay soloists and musicians who accompany us at concerts as well as various administrative costs (e.g., venue rent, insurance, etc.).

Membership fees and ticket sales are important sources of income for the chorus. We also do fundraising (e.g., volunteering at a monthly Delta Bingo event) and apply for a variety of grants each year. As a registered charity, we provide income tax receipts for all donations.
